



# POWER PACK

Packs can be completed over 1 – 2 sessions or developed in to larger unit of study.

## Preview

Use images to hook in, and assess, prior knowledge and understanding of key themes and ideas within the film. POWER PACKS contain at least 5 images for the Preview stage.

## Objects

Encourage watching for detail by getting students to look for key objects within the film, spend time finding the name for each object and recording details on the Objects Resource sheet.

## Words

The Words resource sheet contains 10 words that are linked to themes or ideas within the film that students can research for greater understanding. This resource builds vocabulary in preparation for writing in the Review stage.

## Emotions

This resource contains 8 different pause moments taken from the film and capturing different emotions. Pause at each given time and allow students to discuss body language, facial expression and to empathise with characters. Find synonyms for each emotion offered.

## Review

The Review resource allows students to combine the learning from the previous resources in the pack to produce writing based on the film. A storyboard with 8 boxes enables students to draw different scenes and then add as much information as they are able, from key words through to complete dialogue.
